

Camping regulation

- Arriving campers are asked to report to the Reception desk for registration of their documents.
- The entrance to the Campsite is allowed from 7.30 am to 10.00 pm with their own means, on foot outside this time.
- Campers departing are asked to leave the pitch clean and tidy by 10.00 am to avoid the charge of the whole day. It is preferable to make the payment the evening before departure.
- It is allowed to keep small pets inside the campsite as long as they are kept under control by the owner (dogs on a leash).
- The parking of your own car is allowed only within the assigned pitch or in the specific internal parking area, if available. Motor vehicles must not exceed the speed limit of 5 km per hour.
- External visitors are allowed only with the authorization of the Manager, upon issuance of an identity document.
- From 10.00 p.m. to 7.30 a.m., campers are required to respect the silence (during these period is absolutely forbidden the use of motorized vehicles).
- It is forbidden to smoke inside the common areas (bar/reception, toilets, laundry....).
- It is forbidden to light free fires inside the campsite.
- It is forbidden to cross the fence in correspondence of the cliff.
- It is absolutely forbidden to dig trenches or to ruin the pitch's soil.
- Any damage caused to the structure will be valued and compensated directly to the Manager.
- Toilets are to be left in the same condition in which you wish to find them. Children with under the age of 10 years must always be accompanied by an adult.
- Adults are responsible for the behavior of children entrusted to them.
- The use of games is allowed under adult supervision.
- No responsibility is assumed by the Management for lost or stolen objects and valuables and for damage to persons or property not dependent on the direct negligence of the staff of the campsite. Any liability is limited to events occurring within the fenced area of the campsite itself.
- The Management reserves the right to expel from the campsite those who, in its sole discretion, create damage or disturb the smooth running of community life or do not respect the above mentioned rules.
